

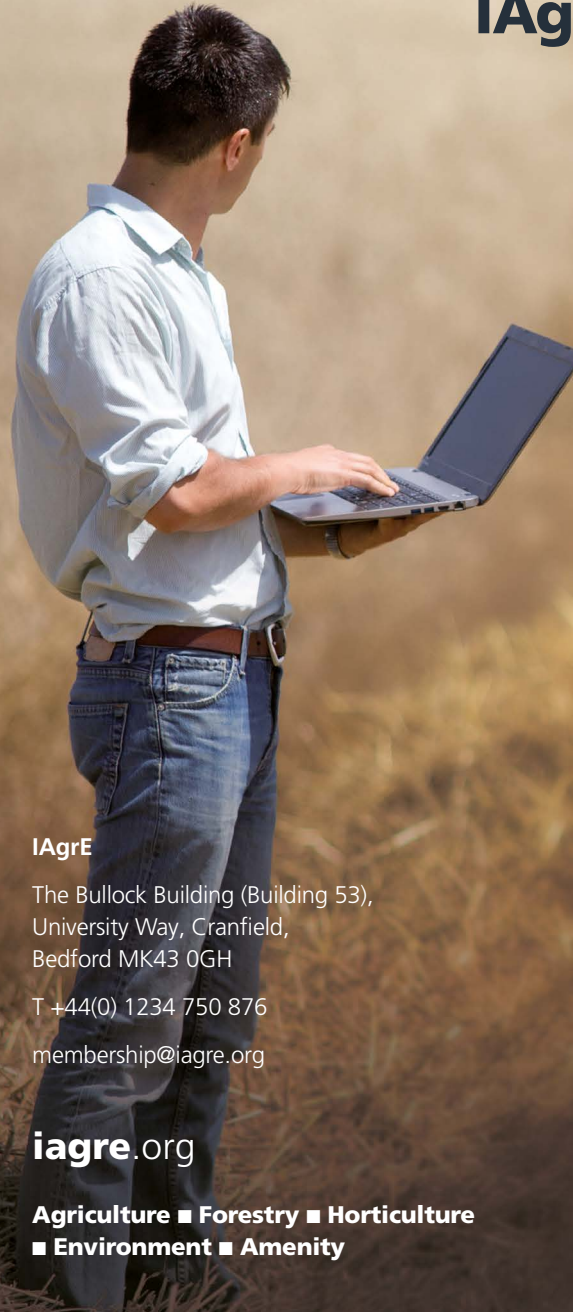
Who are we?

Our membership grades are:

Student

This grade is free and is for students following relevant vocational and university courses in scientific, engineering, landbased technology or other relevant technical subjects in the UK and Ireland. This free membership grade lasts until a year after your graduation, supporting you into your first job.

Affiliate – AIAgrE

For members actively involved or interested in agriculture, engineering or associated landbased technology and who do not necessarily have relevant formal qualifications.

Technician – TIAgrE

For members qualified at vocational level, who have completed an apprenticeship, diploma or similar in agriculture, engineering or associated landbased technology. You could be working in the industry and have early experience and skills developed through your work to date.

Associate Member – AMIAgrE

This is a corporate grade for people who have agricultural, engineering or other relevant technical qualifications in subjects recognised and accepted by IAGrE. You will probably have relevant industry training and experience as well.

Member – MIAgrE

This corporate grade is for those who are well established in their career and have a lengthy record of on-going training and experience.

Fellow – FIAgrE

The highest grade of membership for those with long and established careers in the industry, experts in their field who uphold the highest standards of professionalism.

How much will it cost me?

Student Membership is FREE, sponsored by the Douglas Bomford Trust.

Membership starts from as little as £40 per year but for those who achieve the highest grade of membership and choose to have Chartered Registration fees may be up to £250 per annum.
